Week	Point to Ponder	Verse
Sept. 6-9	Does God listen to any prayer, big or small?	1 Peter 5:7 Cast all your anxiety on him because he cares for you.
Sept. 12-15	Why do people cheat?	Luke 16:10 Whoever can be trusted with very little can also be trusted with much, and whoever is dishonest with very little will also be dishonest with much.
Sept. 19-22	Why do movie companies make scary movies if they know people will be really scared?	Psalms 4:8 In peace I will lie down and sleep, for you alone, LORD, make me dwell in safety.
Sept. 26-29	Do we have to give money to poor people?	Leviticus 25:35 If any of your fellow Israelites become poor and are unable to support themselves among you, help them as you would a foreigner and stranger, so they can continue to live among you.
Oct. 3-6	Does God have things to do at night?	Psalms 121:3-4 He will not let your foot slip— he who watches over you will not slumber; indeed, he who watches over Israel will neither slumber nor sleep.
Oct. 11-14	Does God have friends, or is he alone?	John 15:15 Instead, I have called you friends, for everything that I learned from my Father I have made known to you.
Oct. 17-20	Why do people like different kinds of music?	Job 34:3 For the ear tests words as the tongue tastes food.

Oct. 24-27	What should I do if other kids laugh at me for going to church?	Luke 6:22 Blessed are you when people hate you, when they exclude you and insult you and reject your name as evil, because of the Son of Man
Oct. 31-Nov. 3	When kids tease me, should I tease them back?	1 Peter 3:9 Do not repay evil with evil or insult with insult. On the contrary, repay evil with blessing, because to this you were called so that you may inherit a blessing.
Nov. 7-10	How can we think of something good to pray about if we've had a bad day?	Ephesians 5:19-20 Sing and make music from your heart to the Lord, always giving thanks to God the Father for everything, in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ.
Nov. 15-18	Why can't I have all the things I want?	Luke 12:15 Then he said to them, "Watch out! Be on your guard against all kinds of greed; life does not consist in an abundance of possessions."
Nov. 21-24	Why do we have to learn geography and history?	1 Corinthians 10:11 These things happened to them as examples and were written down as warnings for us, on whom the culmination of the ages has come.
Nov. 28-Dec. 1	Why do we call it "saying grace"?	Hebrews 4:16 Let us then approach God's throne of grace with confidence, so that we may receive mercy and find grace to help us in our time of need.
Dec. 5-8	If God gives us everything we ask for, then how come we don't have everything?	James 4:3 When you ask, you do not receive, because you ask with wrong motives, that you may spend what you get on your pleasures.
Dec. 12-15	Is it OK for people to lie to me about my Christmas presents?	James 5:12 Above all, my brothers and sisters, do not swear—not by heaven or by earth or by anything else. All you need to say is a simple

		“Yes” or “No.” Otherwise you will be condemned.
Dec. 19-22	How did people know that Jesus was coming and what he would be like?	Isaiah 9:6 For to us a child is born, to us a son is given, and the government will be on his shoulders. And he will be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace.
Jan. 9-13	Why do we have the Bible?	Hebrews 4:12 For the word of God is alive and active. Sharper than any double-edged sword, it penetrates even to dividing soul and spirit, joints and marrow; it judges the thoughts and attitudes of the heart.
Jan. 16-20	Does God see everything that we do?	Job 34:21-22 His eyes are on the ways of mortals; he sees their every step. There is no deep shadow, no utter darkness, where evildoers can hide.
Jan. 23-26	What is heaven like?	John 14:2 My Father’s house has many rooms; if that were not so, would I have told you that I am going there to prepare a place for you?
Jan. 31- Feb. 3	What is prayer for?	John 16:24 Until now you have not asked for anything in my name. Ask and you will receive, and your joy will be complete.
Feb. 6-9	What if one parent says you can watch a certain movie, and then the other one says you can’t?	Proverbs 6:20-21 My son, keep your father’s command and do not forsake your mother’s teaching. Bind them always on your heart; fasten them around your neck.
Feb. 13-16	Should I tell the truth to someone even if they won’t like it?	Ephesians 4:15 Instead, speaking the truth in love, we will grow to become in every respect the mature body of him who is the head, that is, Christ.

Feb. 27- Mar. 2	Is it all right to say bad things if there is no one there to hear you?	Ephesians 4:29 Do not let any unwholesome talk come out of your mouths, but only what is helpful for building others up according to their needs, that it may benefit those who listen.

Mar. 13-16	Is it all right to tell a lie once in a while?	Ephesians 4:25 Therefore each of you must put off falsehood and speak truthfully to your neighbor, for we are all members of one body.
Mar. 20-23	What's the difference between being best friends and just being friends?	1 Samuel 18:1 After David had finished talking with Saul, Jonathan became one in spirit with David, and he loved him as himself.
Mar. 27-30	Why do we go to church if God is everywhere?	Hebrews 10:24-25 And let us consider how we may spur one another on toward love and good deeds, not giving up meeting together, as some are in the habit of doing, but encouraging one another...

Apr. 17-21	Why did God put scary stories in the Bible?	1 Corinthians 10:11 These things happened to them as examples and were written down as warnings for us, on whom the culmination of the ages has come.
Apr. 24-27	Why does the world have different religions?	Exodus 20:2-3 I am the LORD your God, who brought you out of Egypt, out of the land of slavery.  You shall have no other gods before me.
